WHAT DOES JOKKMOKK MARKET MEAN TO YOU GUNHILD TJIKKOM, ASA KITOK LAUREATE OF 2019?

We interrupt the exhibition preparations with an interview.



- Jokkmokk market is so important that the year is divided in the time before and after it, says the Asa Kitok laureate of 2019.

As a child I looked forward to seeing all the new and unusual things! Toys, baskets, sami crafts, furs, leathers, paintings and lots of candy. Sometimes there were exhibitions of unusual crafts. I remember an old man who made sculptures with a chainsaw and in Holmbom's workshop another was blowing glass. It was a different time. Us kids accompanied our parents to prayer. To us it was nice to be together, and cool to be in church.

In my youth there tended to be a lot of dancing at the Community House with pop stars like the Shanes.

The artist Rolf Lidberg held exhibitions at Östra (the east) school. He was most famously known as the 'troll painter' and he made some drawings for our boys. A nice memory.

As an adult, I changed profession to be a full-time craftsperson. I exhibited at the market for 25 years. I never miss the exhibitions at Samernas. The young craftspeople are very skilled, and I hope many of them continue.

My profession has opened doors to many exciting places, interesting people and a life of joy and creativity.

After receiving the laureate, I decided to make an exhibition of both old and completely new works side by side. It feels good!

I still meet my old friends and colleagues at the market. Just enjoying everything; fine exhibitions, good food and music.
